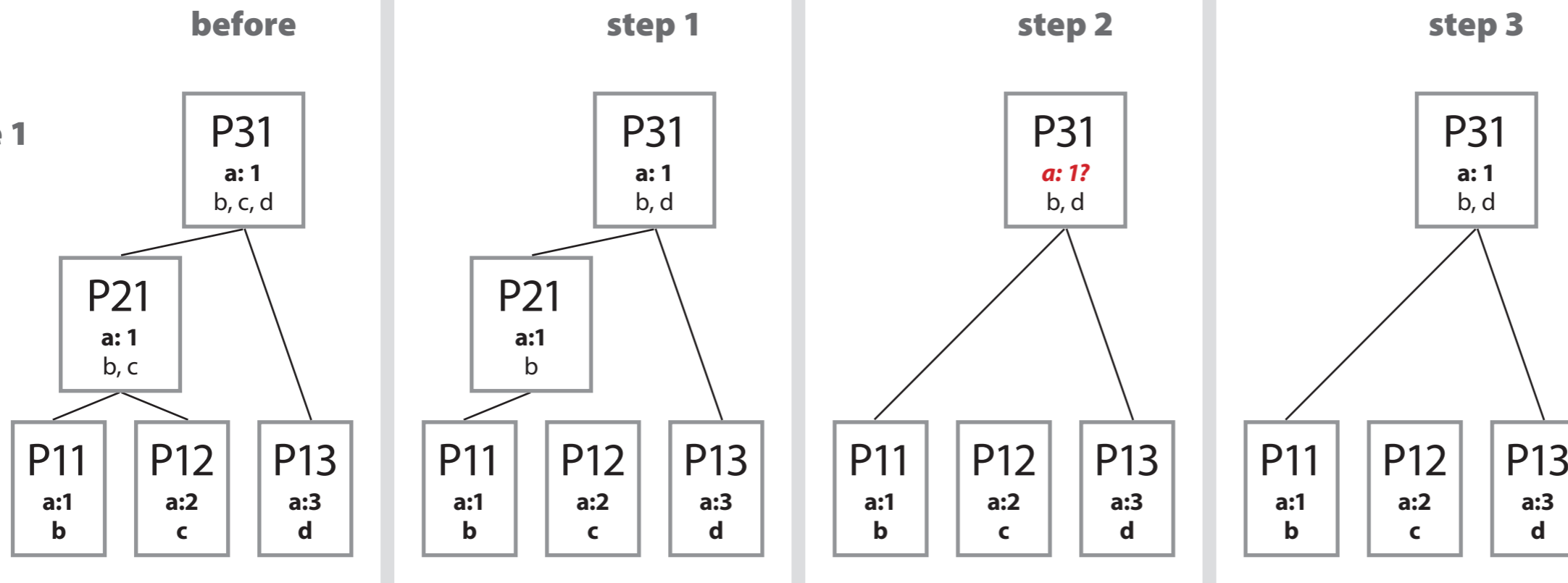


Case 1



*Step 1 –
Taking out the “wrong” Person*

*This is done by removing the link
between the “wrong Person” P12
and the Conclusion P21.*

*If we stopped here, P21 would still
exist and have the values indicated.
A solution for the clash “a” is still
inside.*

*Step 2 –
Removing baggage
asking new questions*

*We don’t need “a” cleared up in P21,
since there’s no clash any longer.
Since P21 has nothing else in it, we
can remove it, too.*

*Now P11 can connect to P31, and
just like in a normal combining, we
have to ask about clashes.
Smart software might offer the
more likely value as default here.*

*Step 3 –
new conclusion finalized*

*We have resolved the clash, and it
has been recorded.*

Undoing a Conclusion step-by-step

*This shows that when you undo a conclusion, you actually take out one (or more!)
of the Records that were combined in that conclusion.*

*I took Case 1 from the “Permutations” but it applies to the other cases as well. Again,
it wouldn’t be necessary to physically delete P21 – unlinking could do the job, too.*
