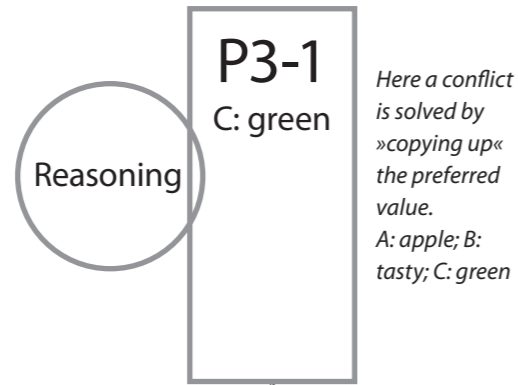
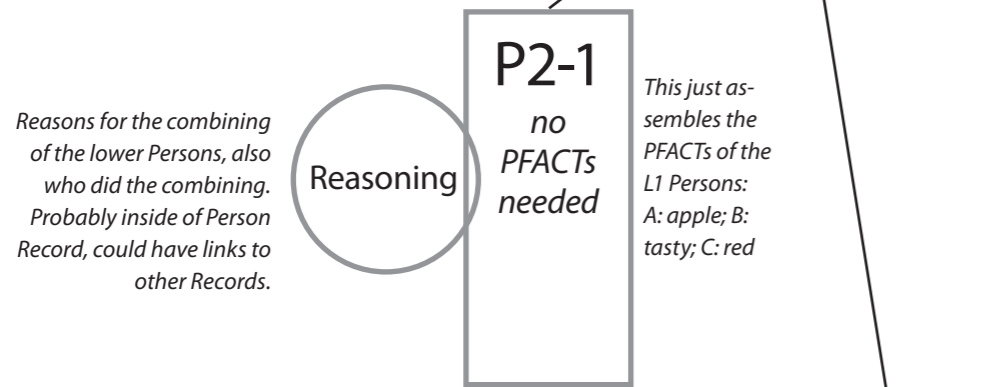


Multi-Level Model

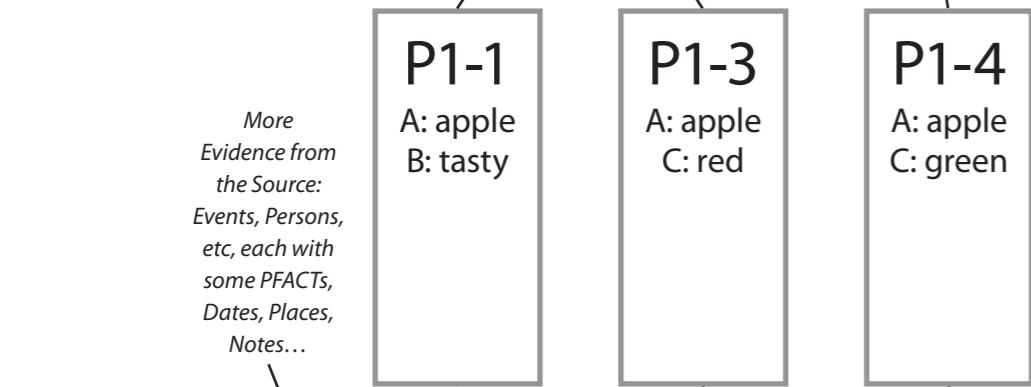

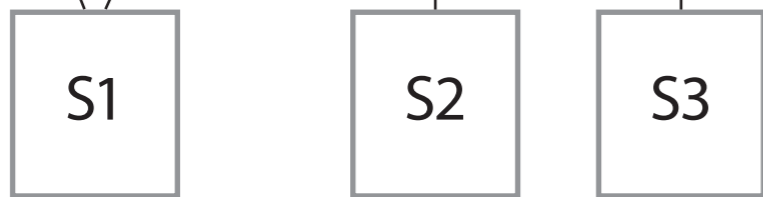

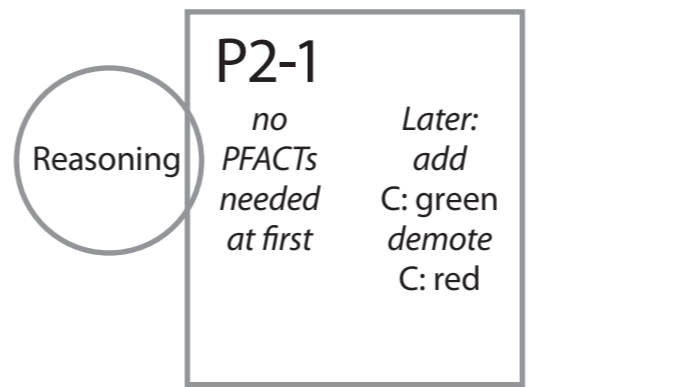


Sources might be nested in a tree themselves, or just refer to a repository.

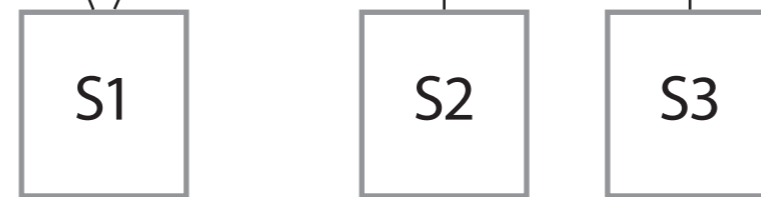
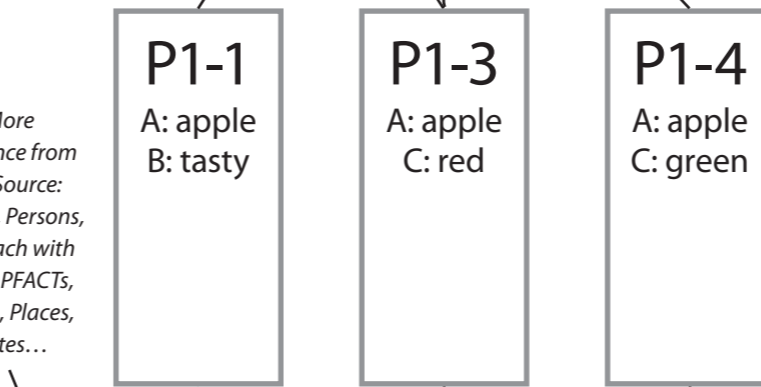
Two-Level Model

Sources and first level (=evidence) are the same as in the Multi-Level-Model. The L2 Person gets changed / added to as new Evidence Records are added. Old links can be »demoted«.

Reasoning is added / changed when new conclusions are made



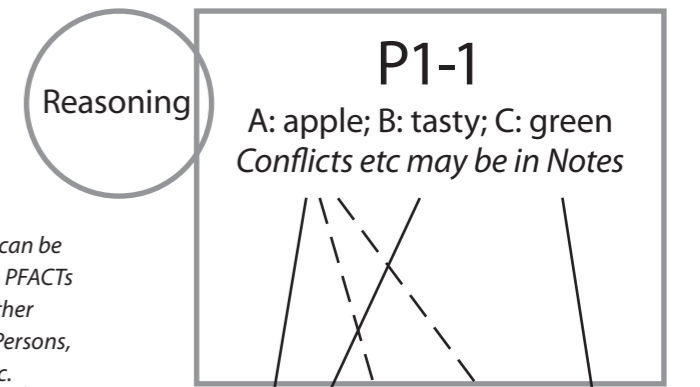
More Evidence from the Source: Events, Persons, etc, each with some PFACTs, Dates, Places, Notes...



One-Level Model

Sources are the same, PFACTs are the same as in the top-level persons before. Each PFACT is sourced seperately, »A« could have three sources.

What's lost is a usable record of the conflict, and the full and true contents of sources (=evidence), e.g. the second PFACT of Source 2.



Source can be linked to PFACTs of other Events, Persons, etc.
